WALLA WALLA COUNTY SEEKING APPLICANTS TO FILL POSITIONS ON THE COUNTY HUMAN SERVICES ADVISORY BOARD

Walla Walla County is seeking applicants for up to five (5) openings on the combined Human Services Advisory Board (HSAB). The HSAB is responsible for assisting the Department of Community Health (DCH) in determining needs and setting priorities for services, and assists the department in evaluating and monitoring the Behavioral Health, Developmental Disabilities and Homeless Housing plans and service delivery. Also, the HSAB provides recommendations to DCH and Walla Walla County Board of Commissioners in each of the service delivery programs. HSAB members should have some background, personal experience and/or knowledge in Behavioral Health (Mental Health, Substance Use Disorders), and/or Developmental Disability. Time commitments to this board include one afternoon board meeting per month (usually the second Monday of the month). At least one-quarter of the advisory board must be made up of those persons who have recovered from a behavioral health condition, so special emphasis will be made to identify and seat such. Board members must be residents of Walla Walla County, be willing to attend monthly afternoon board meetings, and have no personal financial interest in County funded programs or other potential conflict of interest (i.e. employee of County contracted provider).
