Replacement of Expiring Capital Levy for Technology Improvements

The Board of Directors of Columbia School District No. 400 adopted Resolution No. 2122-02, concerning a proposition to finance technology improvements. This proposition would authorize the District to acquire and install technology and communication equipment and make other technology improvements and upgrades to enhance student learning, by levying the following excess taxes, in place of an expiring levy, upon all taxable property within the District:

Bonds to Renovate and Improve School Facilities

The Board of Directors of Columbia School District No. 400 adopted Resolution No. 2122-03, concerning a proposition to add classrooms and improve safety and infrastructure. This proposition would authorize the District to: upgrade and renovate Columbia Middle School for new classrooms; make District-wide safety, security, athletic and infrastructure improvements (including making student safety and security improvements; upgrading restrooms, athletic facilities and Auditorium lighting and sound; and improving community access); issue no more than \$5,266,000 of general obligation bonds maturing within 6 years, and levy annual excess property taxes to repay the bonds, all as provided in Resolution No. 2122-03.
