**CORRECTIONS OFFICERS ACADEMY PHYSICAL ABILITY TEST
(PAT) GUIDELINES:**

In order to comply with WAC 139-10-212 “Physical Requirements for Admission to Basic Correction Academies,” Academy applicants are required to demonstrate a requisite level of fitness for training purposes prior to entrance. As a requirement of the position, as stated in the job description, “Must be able to obtain, within six (6) months, a Certificate of Corrections Officer”, which is obtained by completing the Corrections Officer Academy.

The Corrections Division PAT measures aerobic capacity, strength, and flexibility using three events: push-ups, sit-ups, and squat thrusts. Failure to demonstrate the required level of fitness within the overall assessment will result in ineligibility for academy attendance and completion.
